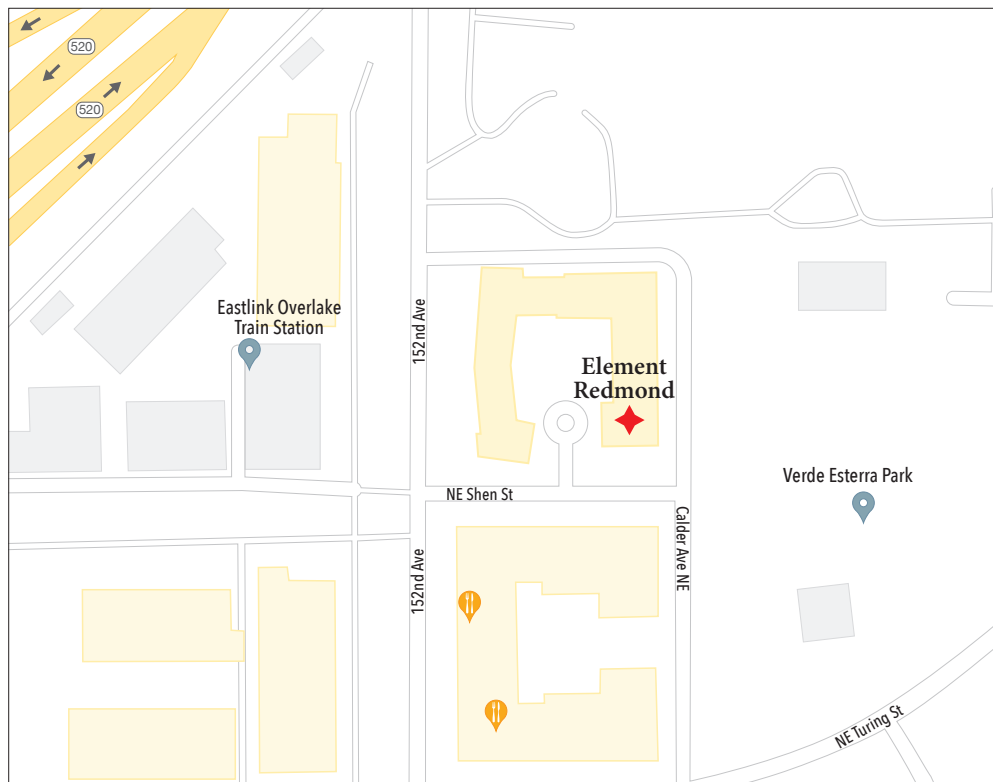
## TARGET AUDIENCE

### ■ From Everett to Redmond

I-5 South (1.6 miles)  
Take I-405 S to 148th Ave NE in Bellevue (27.3 miles)  
Take the 148th Ave NE S exit from WA-520 E  
Take NE 24th St. and 152nd Ave NE to the hotel (.07 miles)  
*Approximately 47 minutes*

### ■ From Seattle to Redmond

I-90 East to Bellevue  
Exit 11 B from I-90 E (10.5 miles)  
Continue on 148th Ave SE to the hotel (3.8 miles)  
*Approximately 23 minutes*

### ■ From Vancouver, WA to Redmond

I-5 N to Bellevue  
Take the 148th Ave NE S exit from WA-520 E (170 miles)  
Take NE 24th St. and 152nd Ave NE to the hotel (.07 miles)  
*Approximately 2 hours and 48 minutes*

### ■ From Spokane to Redmond

I-90 West (269 miles)  
Follow I-90 W to SE Eastgate Way in Bellevue  
Take exit 11 from I-90 W  
Take 148th Ave SE to the hotel (4.3 miles)  
*Approximately 4 hours and 11 minutes*
